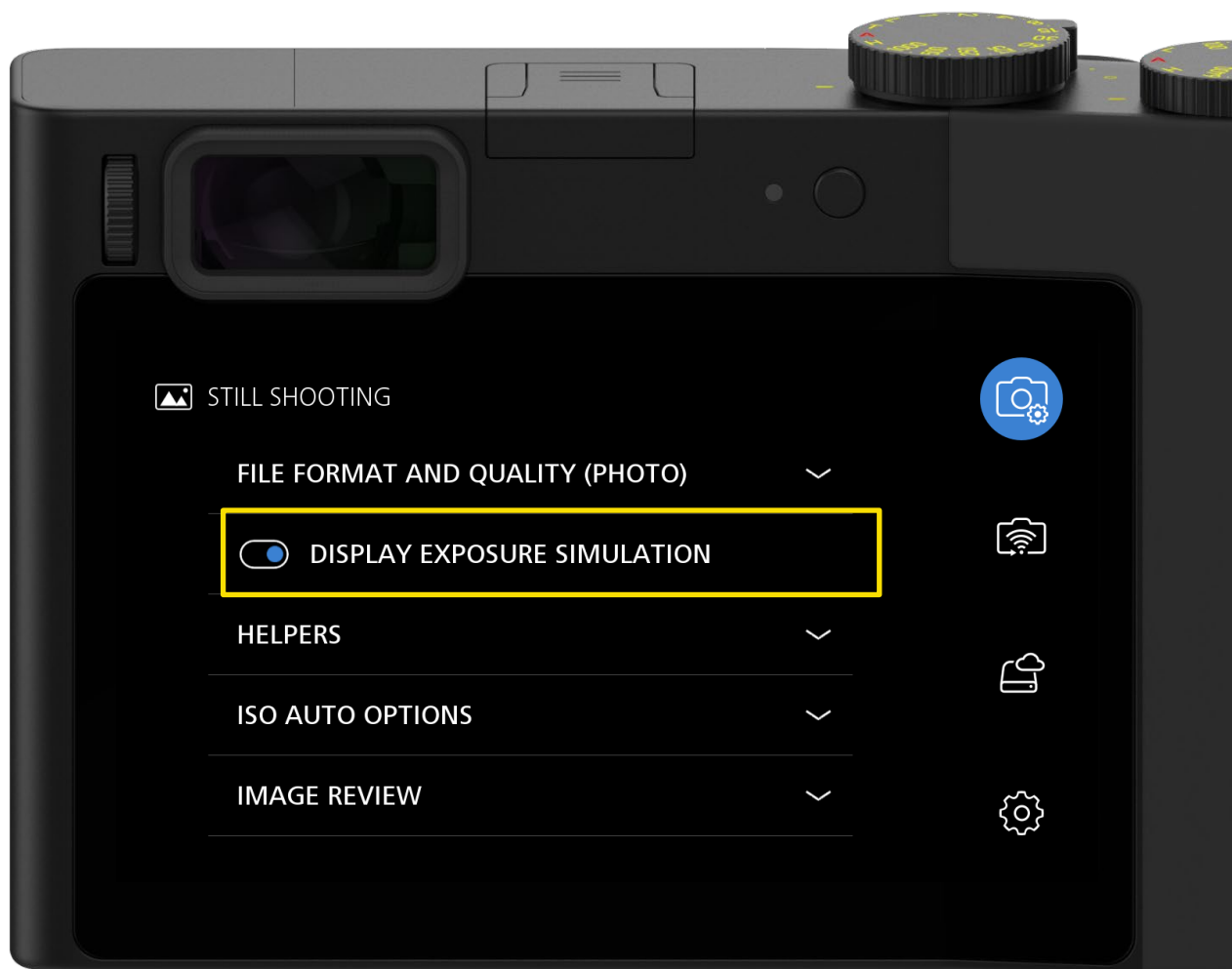

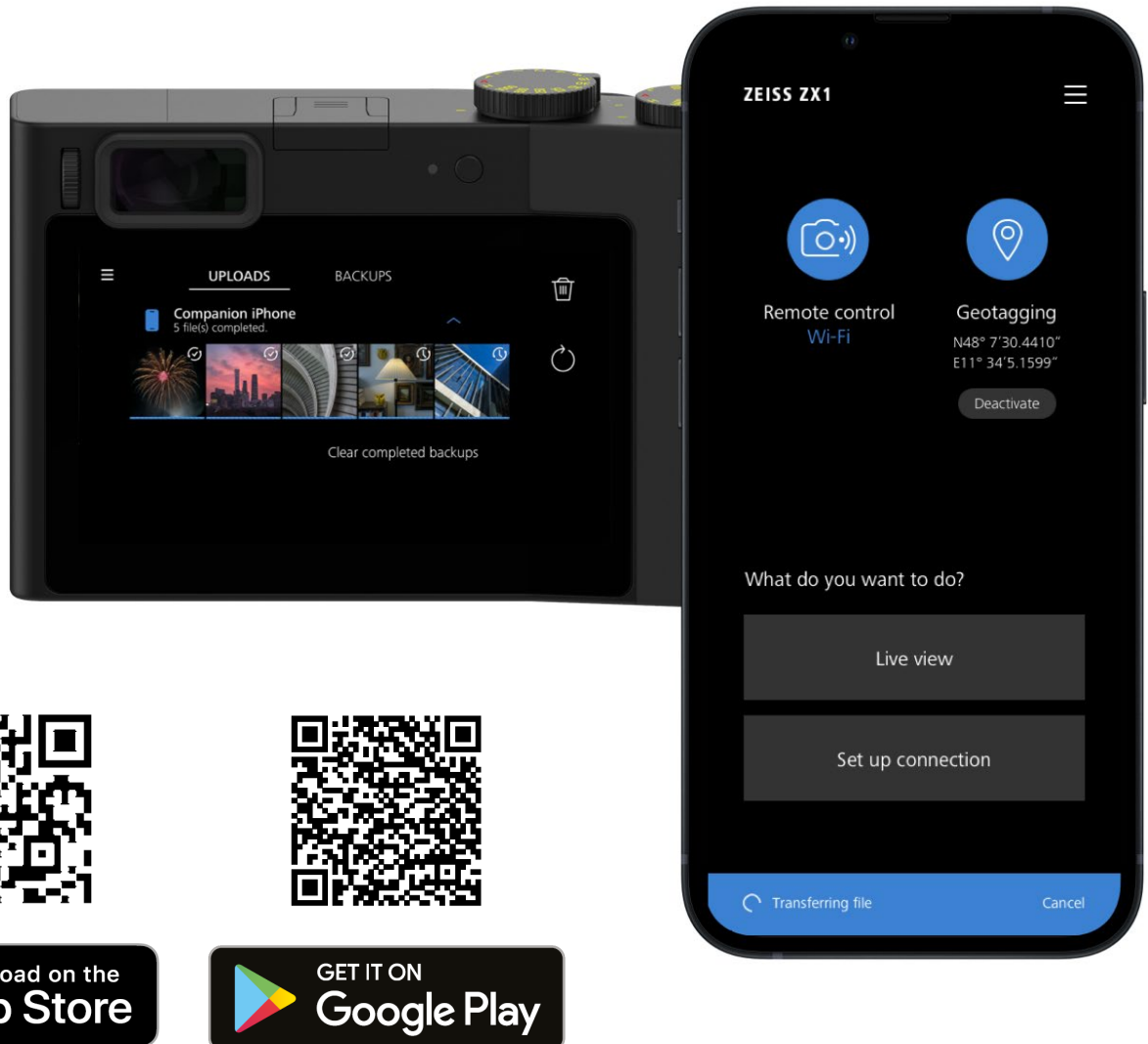
With this firmware update (2.2), we have added some new features to the ZEISS ZX1 as well as some improvements:

New features:

- A new option “Display Exposure Simulation” in Settings mode is now supported to show the live view with simulated brightness.
 - When activated, the live view will show the picture with simulated brightness of the scene. In most shooting scenario this makes exposure adjustment more intuitive.
 - When disabled, the live view gives well-exposed image and shows actual brightness when you are half-pressing the shutter button. This may be helpful to review photo composition in a studio environment, when the major light source is coming from the flash lighting(s).



- Support for the upcoming ZX1 Companion app release is integrated.
 - New feature: selected pictures and videos can be shared easily from the camera gallery to your ZX1 Companion device via Wi-Fi connection. (Note: requires ZX1 Companion app version 1.1.2 or higher)



Bug fixes / improvements:

- The latest release of Adobe Lightroom (version 7.1.1) from December 2021 is integrated.
- A new version of the user manual is integrated.
- Other improvements.
